DR. GEORGE TYNDALL SURVIVORS CALL ON ATTORNEY GENERAL TO LAUNCH INVESTIGATION OF USC ADMINISTRATION

***Survivors' attorneys file additional 91 lawsuits against USC alleging university ignored
complaints of Tyndall's abuse for decades and concealed his actions***

WHAT: Attorneys representing former University of Southern California students filed 91 additional lawsuits against the University of Southern California in Los Angeles Superior Court today alleging gross sexual misconduct and sexual assault on the USC campus by Dr. George Tyndall, a gynecologist at the USC student health center for nearly 30 years. This latest filing brings the number of cases filed against USC to more than 400.

20 survivors of Dr. George Tyndall will call upon members of the USC Board of Trustees to speak out on behalf of survivors. They will also ask Attorney General Xavier Becerra to launch an independent investigation of the USC administration.

These survivors will be joined by Rachael Denhollander and Sarah Klein, recipients of the 2018 Arthur Ashe Courage Award for their work on behalf of survivors of the Larry Nassar sexual abuse scandal.
