## LARRY NASSAR SURVIVORS TO SPEAK AT PENNSYLVANIA SEXUAL ABUSE SURVIVOR RALLY

**WHAT:** Larry Nassar Survivors Rachael Denhollander and Jamie Dantzscher will speak at a rally organized by victims and advocates on Monday, September 24 as they light the Capitol blue in support of sexual abuse survivors and quick passage of the four reforms recommended by Pennsylvania's statewide Grand Jury. Attorney General Josh Shapiro, Governor Tom Wolf, First Lady Frances Wolf and CHILD USA founder Marci Hamilton will voice their support for these critical reforms, which will eliminate the criminal statute of limitations on child sexual abuse, strengthen mandatory reporting requirements, extend the civil statute of limitations, and specify that civil confidentiality agreements do not cover communications with law enforcement. The rally will feature speakers sharing their stories and calling on the Pennsylvania Legislature to act in defense of survivors of child sexual abuse.
